Wild Carrot (<i>Daucus carota</i>)	Also known as bird's nest. Flowers mid-late Summer, attracting insects enjoyed by birds. Seeds in September and October provide a food source in the Autumn months.	10 - 150cm	P	UK Native						
Cornflower (<i>Centaurea cyanus</i>)	Provides direct food sources with seeds favoured by Finches.	50 - 100cm	A	UK Native						
Ox-eye Daisy (<i>Leucanthemum vulgare</i>)	A UKHab lowland calcareous grassland indicator species, offering food and shelter for birds.	50 - 100cm	P	UK Native						
Common Knapweed (<i>Centaurea nigra</i>)	Attracts insects enjoyed by birds and provides seeds in Autumn.	50 - 100cm	P	UK Native						
Field Scabious (<i>Knautia arvensis</i>)	A UKHab lowland calcareous grassland indicator species, providing food sources and habitat for garden birds.	50 - 150cm	P	UK Native						
Teasel (<i>Dipsacus fullonum</i>)	Offers both food and water sources for garden birds.	100 - 200cm	BI	UK Native
