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Common Knapweed (<i>Centaurea nigra</i>)	Attracts insects enjoyed by birds and provides seeds in Autumn.	P	UK Native						
Common Poppy (<i>Papaver rhoeas</i>)	This iconic wildflower creates vibrant displays and offers abundant pollen.	A	UK Native						
Cornflower (<i>Centaurea cyanus</i>)	Vivid blue, thistle-like flowers, excellent nectar source for bees and butterflies.	A	UK Native						
Cosmos (<i>Cosmos bipinnatus</i>)	Cosmos is a rich source of nectar and pollen, highly attractive to various pollinators.	A	UK Native						
Field Scabious (<i>Knautia arvensis</i>)	A UKHab lowland calcareous grassland indicator species, providing food sources and habitat for garden birds.	P	UK Native						
English (Pot) Marigold (<i>Calendula officinalis</i>)	It's cheerful orange flowers serve as a strong magnet for pollinators.	BI	UK Native						
Oxeye Daisy (<i>Leucanthemum vulgare</i>)	A UKHab lowland calcareous grassland indicator species, offering food and shelter for birds.	P	UK Native						
Teasel (<i>Dipsacus fullonum</i>)	Offers both food and water sources for garden birds.	BI	UK Native						
Wild Carrot (<i>Daucus carota</i>)	Seeds in September & October providing a food source in the Autumn months.	P	UK Native
