Cowslip (<i>Primula veris</i>)	Early-bloomer, vital food source for various butterfly species.	25	P	UK Native								
Greater Knapweed (<i>Centaurea scabiosa</i>)	A favourite for all kinds of butterflies.	100	P	UK Native
